

If you're involved in an ACCIDENT

DO

- Get uninjured passengers out of vehicle to the side of the road, safely away from the vehicle and oncoming traffic.
- Call the police immediately. If a phone is not available, ask at least two people to call.
- Call an ambulance if anyone is injured.
- Put out reflectors at least 300 feet towards oncoming traffic.
- Get the names, addresses, and phone numbers of witnesses.
- If vehicle is unsafe to drive, have it towed to Carubba Collision.
- Report the accident to your insurance agent or company within 24 hours.
- Call Carubba Collision
- Report the accident to the DMV if over \$1,000.

DON'T

Make any statements about the accident to anyone but the police.

Accept any informal settlements.

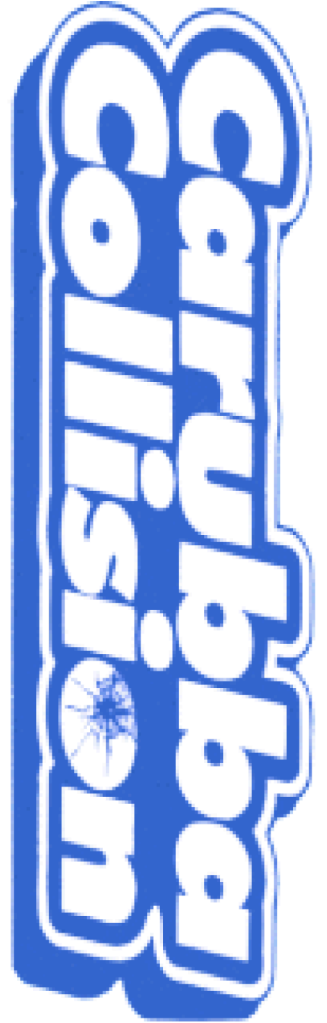
